

GUIDELINES FOR PRACTICE SCHOOL

[B. Pharm Program (VII semester)]

1. Every candidate shall undergo for practice school for 150 hours evenly distributed throughout the VII semester.
2. At least one guide should be allotted for conducting practice school for each group of students which may be 4-5 in numbers.
3. Student has to opt one domain for practice school as decided by the allocated supervisor/guide.
4. A group of 4 to 5 students shall be assigned to a supervisor/guide in beginning of VII semester.
5. All students have to give weekly update to the supervisor/guide for their work progress.
6. For internal assessment students has to present outline of the work to their specific guide.
7. Each individual guide has to submit continuous internal assessment (CIA) value out of maximum 25 mark (including 5 marks for attendance, 10 marks for class performance and 10 marks for presentation/viva voce) to the exam department before initiation of end semester exam.
8. At the end of semester, Printed Report on practice school should be submitted in triplicate by each student separately which will not be in more than 25 pages.
9. Weekly 12 hours working load has to be assigned for practice school (6 credit points) subject.
10. At the end of semester along with printed report a presentation will be given in front of the expert panel.
11. At the end of semester exam, practice school will be evaluated out of 125 marks which includes properly formatted (triplat) Printed report submission (50 marks), Presentation (25 marks), Viva voce (25 marks) and Evidence of paper submission for publication (25 marks).
